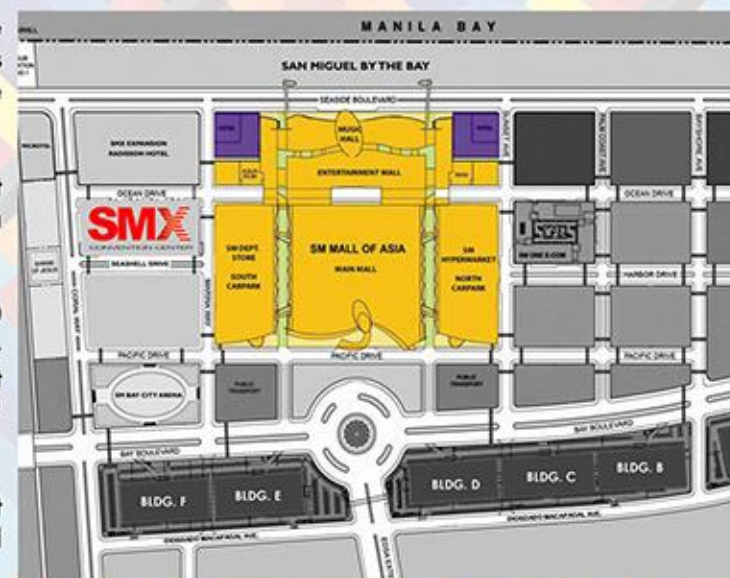
## ABOUT THE VENUE
